REMINDERS

- Please ensure that you let us know when your child won't be attending nursery and why. The numbers you will need are: 0115 876 2623 when telephoning and 07796246598 when texting.
- Regular attendance is important for children attending on the two year programme. Places may be reviewed and withdrawn if children do not attend regularly.
- If your child has had sickness or diarrhoea they should be kept away from nursery until they have been well for 48 hours. Please keep your child's nails short as long nails can scratch and spread bugs.
- Now that the weather is getting colder please ensure your child comes to nursery in warm clothing and has a jacket or coat and suitable footwear. Please ensure if your child comes to nursery wearing their wellies that they have a spare pair of shoes to change into after outdoor play.
- Please remember to make sure your child has enough nappies and wipes for the session and also a change of clothes. Please put your child's name in their clothing so that members of staff can place it on the correct peg at home time.
- It is extremely important that children are collected on time from nursery. Even very young children learn our routine and know when their parents are due. They can become distressed if you are late. Whilst we acknowledge sometimes delays are unavoidable, you must arrange for another authorised adult to collect your child in the event that you are unable to do so yourself. You need to also contact the nursery to let us know someone else is collecting your child to enable us to follow the correct procedure to keep your child safe.
